And what about Boyz II Men's latest top tenner, a remake of the Five Satins' 1950s hit, "In The Still Of The Night". They could be back on top again! It could happen. 2. **CHART ACTION TO THE MAX AND MORE!** :34

Bobby Brown and Whitney Houston became the first husband and wife in 15 years to be back to back with separate solo hits.
